Unfortunately, a competent scholar who would replace Vladimír Vavřínek in his post has not been found so far. Therefore, the Slavonic Institute cannot but suspend the publication of this journal for the time being. None the less, it is our firm intention to renew it in the future once again and the Slavonic Institute of the Czech Academy of Sciences claims the exclusive right to use the title "*Byzantinoslavica*" also in the years to come.
